Food Insecurity & Homelessness

Ongoing projects and partnerships support persons who are experiencing food insecurity and homelessness:

- Suthers Center for Christian Outreach is a Saturday drive-up food and assistance ministry for DeKalb County at nearby St. Martin in the Fields Episcopal Church which BCC has supported for many years through donations, volunteers, and drives. Learn more at sutherscenter.org.
- Interfaith Outreach Home (IOH) is a 10-unit (and growing) apartment building which houses and serves homeless families for up to 2 years while they achieve permanent self-sufficiency. BCC, a founding partner, supports IOH through donations, special projects, and holiday support.
- Little Free Pantry is an on-site ministry at BCC that features a mini food pantry installed in 2021 on the west side of the building, on Lanier Drive. Church members and friends stock the pantry which is open to all. Learn more about this movement at littlefreepantry.org.
- Blessing Bags are a way of serving persons who are experiencing homelessness. A ready supply of these bags, filled with up to 25 different food and hygiene items, plus water, are distributed by a steady group of BCC volunteers throughout the month.



Children's Growth & Nurture

Children have been a primary focus of our church's ministry in Brookhaven since 1995, when the Brookhaven Christian Church Child Development Center opened. Here are some of the ways we serve children:

- BCC Child Development Center is fully licensed and accredited, offering full-day care for infants through preschoolers, as well as two Georgia Pre-K classes and after-school care. BCC supports the center through volunteers, teacher appreciation, books for children, and other projects.
- **Backpacks and School Supplies** are collected and distributed by BCC each school year to four DeKalb County elementary schools, for use by school staff in supporting underserved students in the community.
- **Presencia** is an after-school program serving a nearby apartment complex whose residents are primarily immigrant children. BCC provides volunteers, donations, and other support. Learn more at presenciaatl.org.
- Camp Christian Conference Center is a Disciples of Christ summer camping facility in Gordon, GA which has served generations of Georgia Disciples, including children and youth of BCC. BCC is a long-time supporter of the camp. Learn more at gadisciples.org/camp.

Hospitality & Welcome

Extend hospitality to strangers (Romans 12:13)

From support of global partners and refugees, to events in our parking lot, to the feeling you get on Sunday morning when all are invited to the communion table, welcome is central to who we are at Brookhaven Christian Church. Here are some of the other ways we offer hospitality:

- **Community Events** at Brookhaven Christian Church range from selling pumpkins or yard sale items to giving away hot cocoa and singing carols. Look for the big red striped tent for the next event coming soon.
- **Mission Angeles** is a preschool program in Puerto Cortez, Honduras, which offers early childhood education, as well as access to immunizations, nutrition, and parent education to a very underserved population. BCC offers support with an annual fundraiser which pays the teacher's salary and enables property development.
- **Inspiritus** is a refugee agency in Atlanta through which BCC has provided mentoring and donations for immigrants. Learn more at weinspirit.org.
- Week of Compassion is our Disciples disaster, refugee, and development fund that enables BCC to be on the ground responding to significant needs around the globe. BCC collects an annual offering for Week of Compassion and supports other needs as they emerge.
