

Little Free Pantry

Brookhaven Christian Church has a [Little Free Pantry](#) on church property, located on the west side of the building, along Lanier Drive. This mini food pantry is an easy way for neighbors to help neighbors and others who need food, water, personal care, or paper items. Even though its home is on this property, **this mini pantry belongs to all of us**. The guiding principle is “Take what you need, give what you can.”

Take what you need. If you find items inside and you need them, take them and know we care about you. Please remember the mini pantry belongs to all of us and take only those items you need, trusting the mini pantry will be here for you again

Give what you can by placing food, bottled water, hygiene, or paper items inside the mini pantry. Give what you would want to receive. Get in the habit of buying an extra item or two for the pantry when food shopping. **Suggested items:**

- **Bottled water/juice**
- **Protein bars, crackers, chips, cookies (no chocolate in warm months – it melts)**
- **Flip-top cans of soup, meat, meals, fruit, veggies, especially individual sizes**
- **Wrapped toiletries, (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.), flatware, napkins**
- **Items should be unopened and unexpired. No books, please**

Items which we are unable to use (larger items, etc.) are donated to the Suthers Center for Christian Outreach food pantry.

This mini food pantry is an outreach project of Brookhaven Christian Church, offering an opportunity to give and to receive. Neighbors, members, and friends are welcome to place donations directly in the pantry; donations also may be dropped off at the church on Sunday mornings (9am-12:30 pm) or Wednesday evenings (6-8 pm).
